In response to the Provincial Statement on Friday November 20th regarding The Regional Municipality of Durham entering the **RED ZONE** in the prevention of COVID-19, effective Monday November 23rd 2020 Bowmanville Older Adult Association will be cancelling all in-person activities, with the exception of our partnership Footcare Services.

PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING PRIOR TO ENTRY:


1. Stay home if you are sick
2. A signed admission checklist that includes a temperature check will be required
3. Masks are required at all times within the building
4. All participants must remain six feet apart when possible
5. Please wash your hands frequently
6. Strict facility maximums and physical distancing will be enforced.
7. Please use hand sanitizer frequently
8. Do not touch your eyes, nose or mouth

ADDITIONAL SAFETY MEASURES:

2. Our team will be following social distancing protocols and our floors will have distancing guidelines
