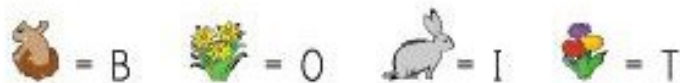

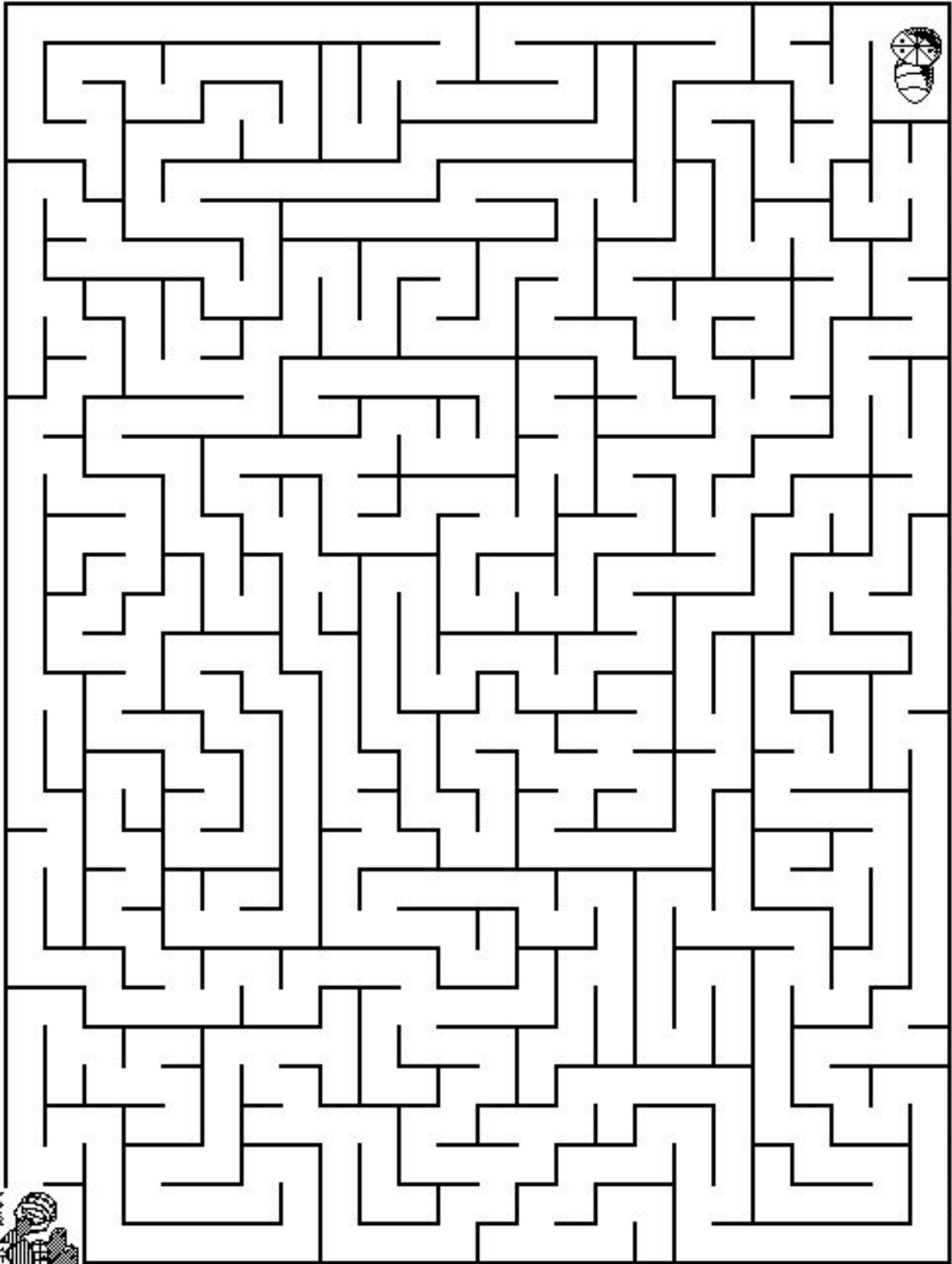
Spring Secret Message Puzzle

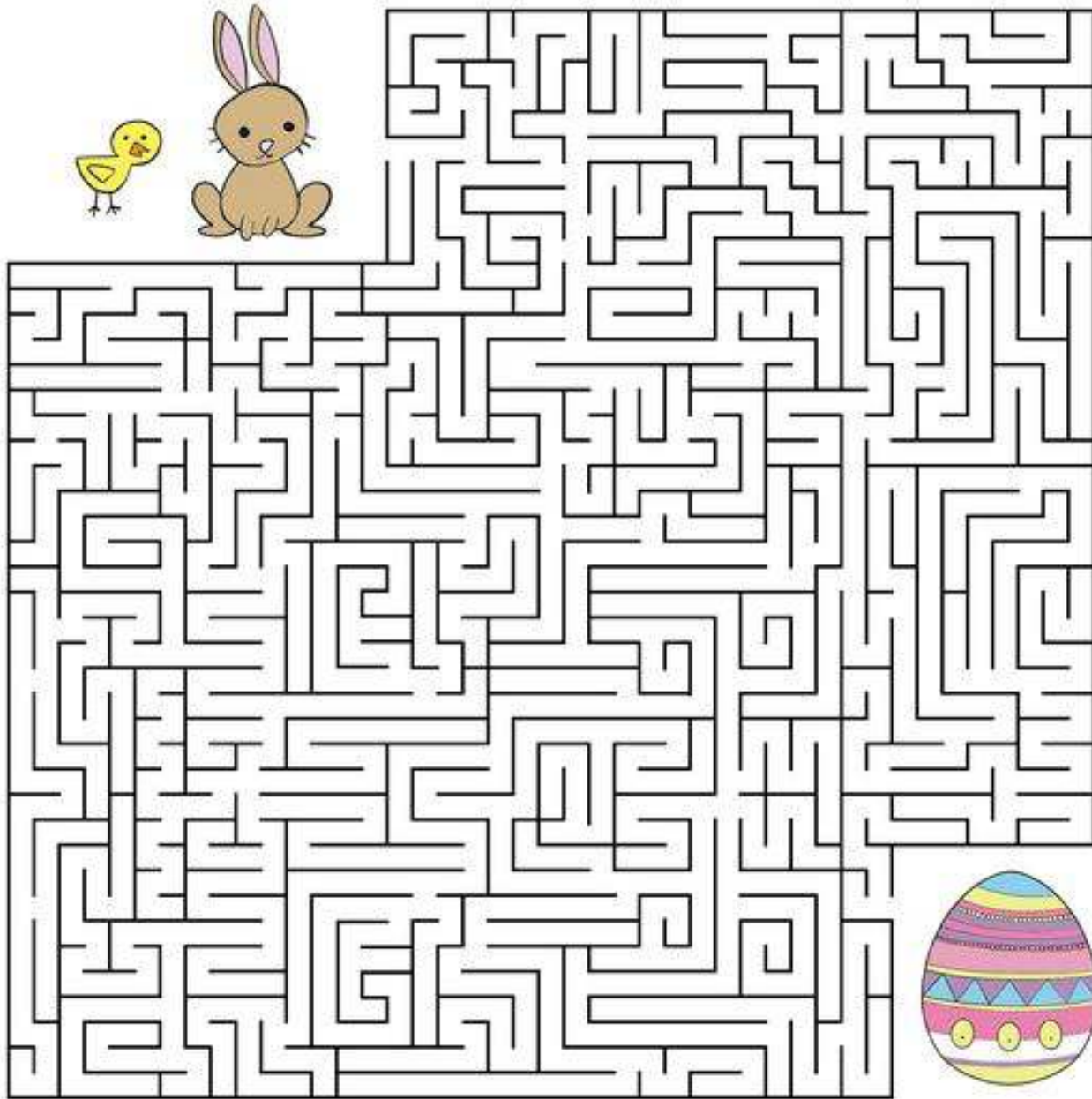

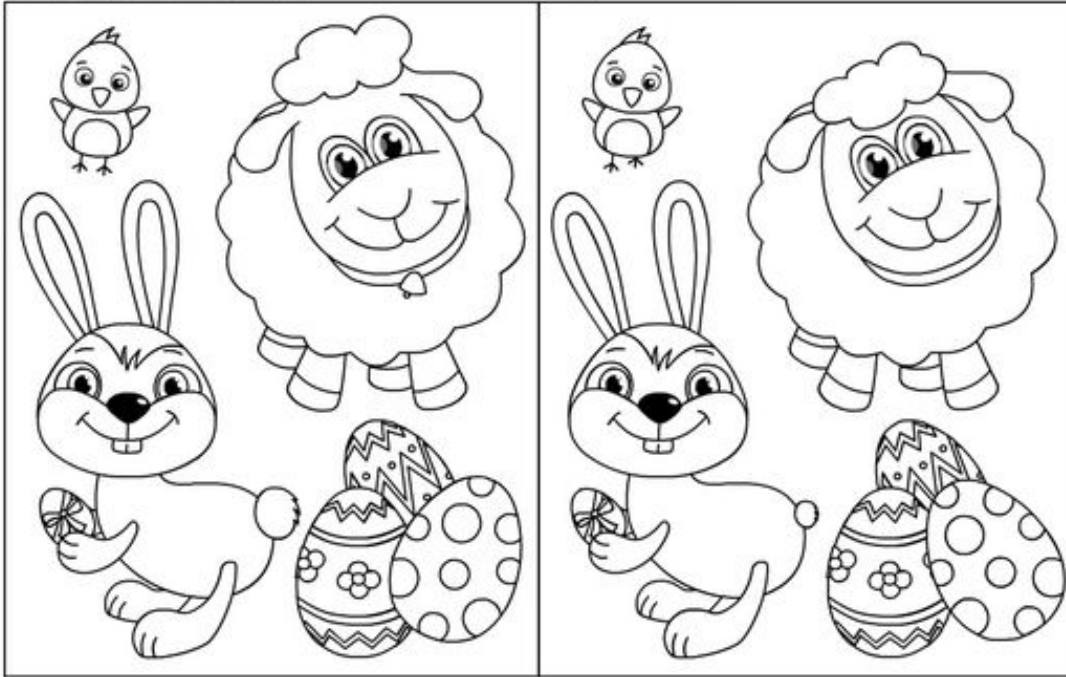

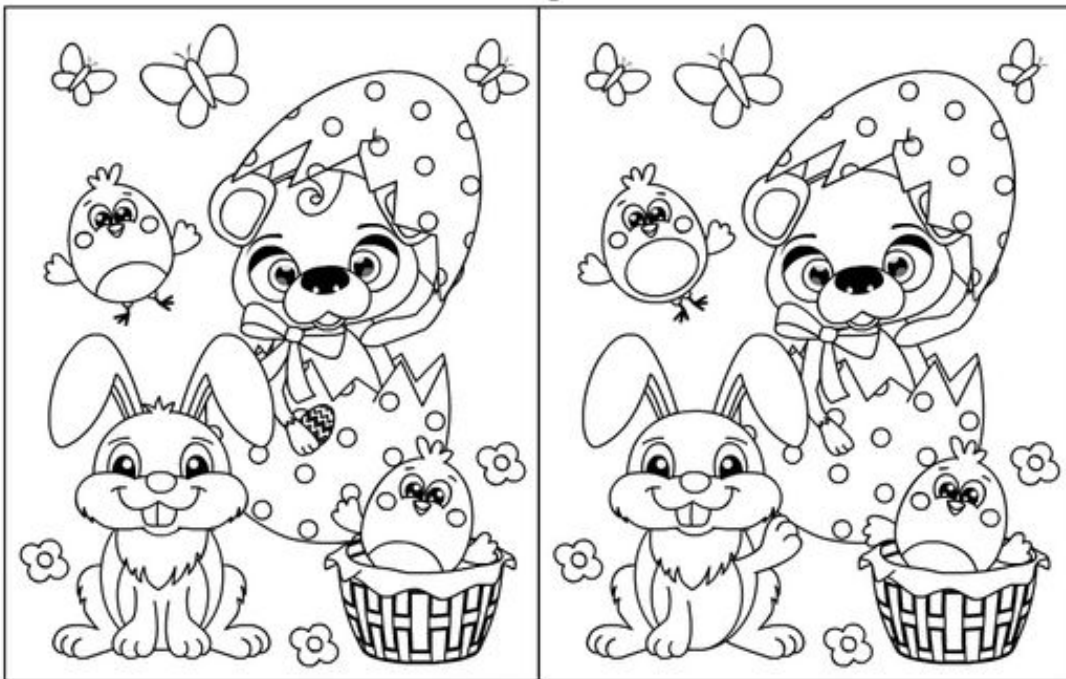
